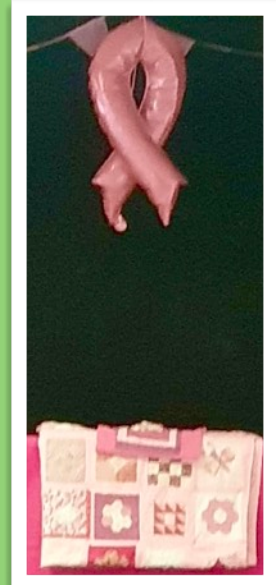

The garden is loaded with lots of Mediterranean plants making this method of propagation easy to do.

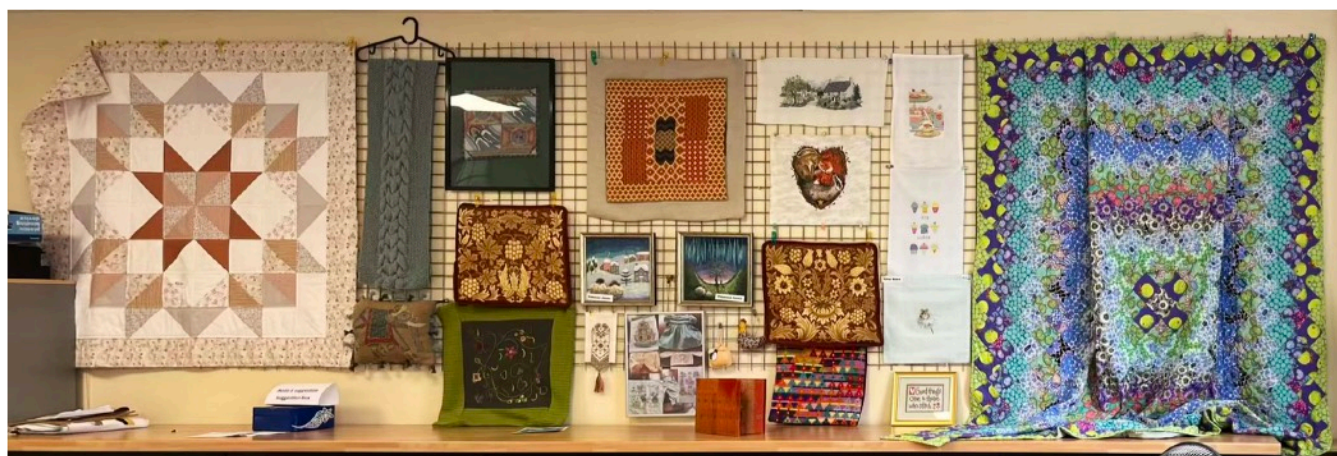
We took various plants : herbs, salvias, penstemons, verveines for cuttings (bouturage).

We used good seed starter soil, a bit of water, small pots, markers to remind us what is in the various seed pots and some of our hot air blown into a plastic bag over the pot, and created a small potting serres.

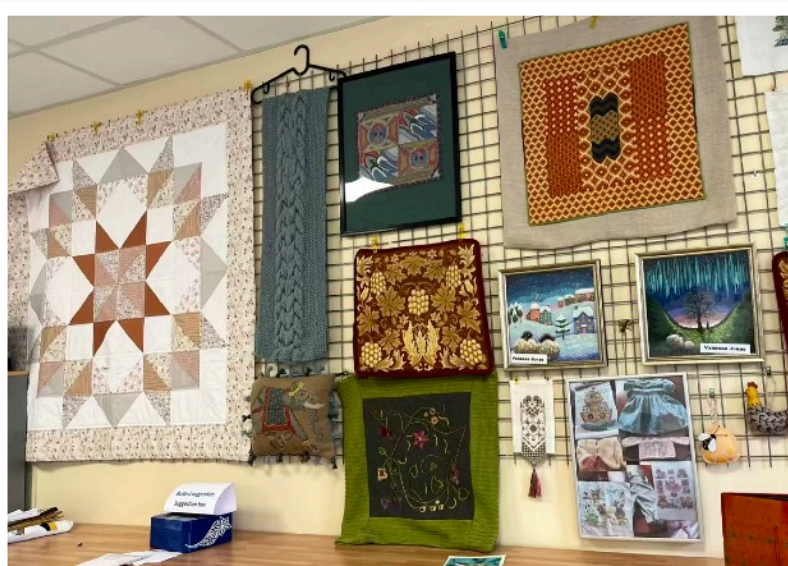

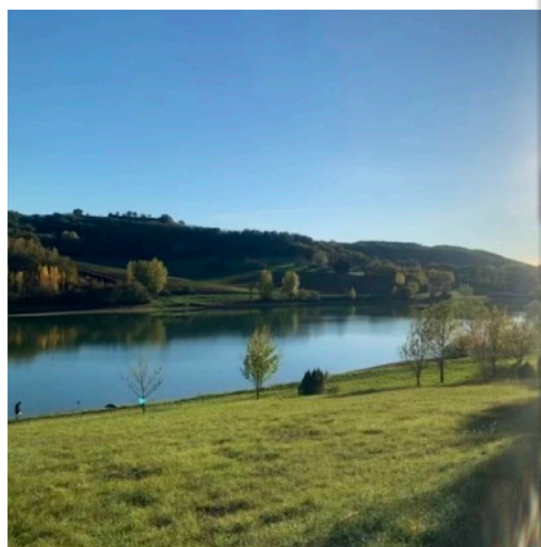

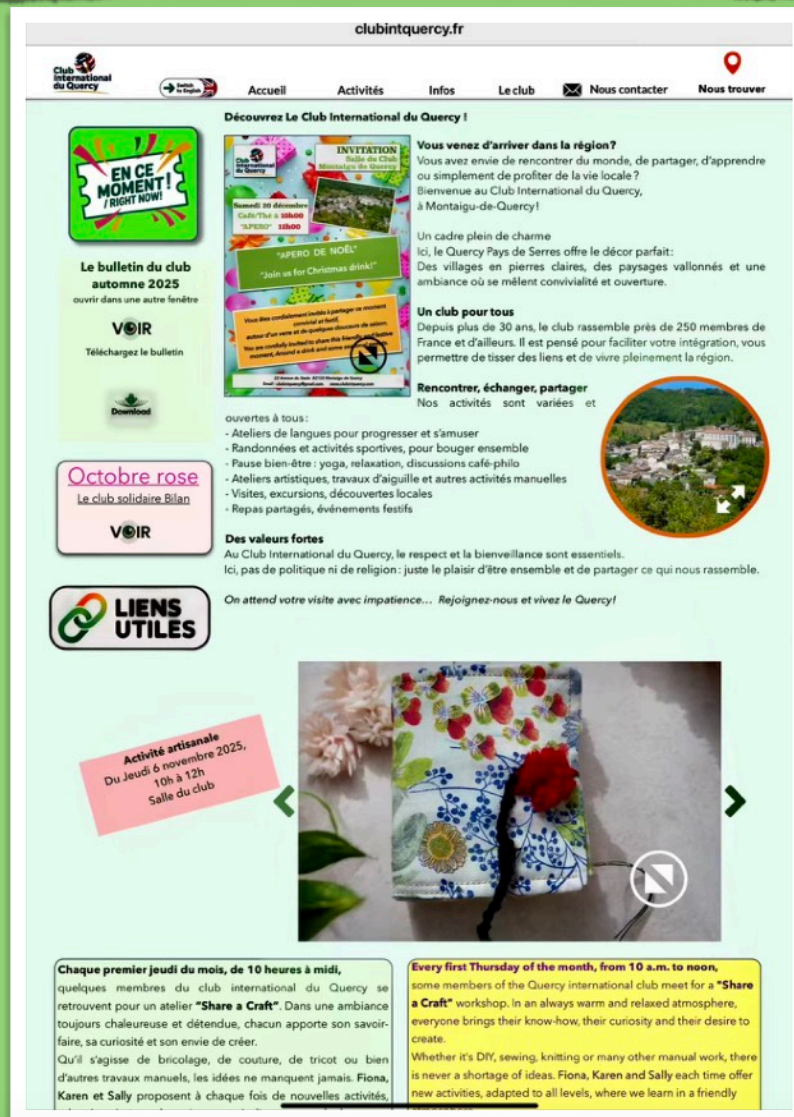
